### ***Selectmen's Meeting Minutes***

***August 13, 2012***

***Call Selectmen's Meeting to Order:*** The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 PM. Shouldering needs to be cleaned up. Betts Road has been paved as well. But the driveway entrances have not. Center Drive up by Kings Mountain is being worked on.

**13. Board Comments:** Goody thanks PW for cutting brush by gun club. Also wants to know who to talk to about the school bus turn around on the Richardson Road. Made note of John Hodgins' resignation letter. Grover mentioned the hydroseed bill and the work that was being billed for. Grover talked about having the equipment rental contract. He noted that White and D&H negotiated a separate contract for the Richardson road project, while the equipment rental contract was in place already. Grover also noted that we had already paid Clisham for gravel to be delivered to Richardson Road that may have been substandard to Town's specs. Grover's last question was about the Sebago Technics bill regarding the business park on Brewer Lake Road and wondered when their part of the project will be finished.
