Call Selectmen's Meeting to Order: The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order

11. *Approve Warrant Articles for Town Meeting of June 3, 2013:* Lavoie moved to approve the warrant articles as presented. Bladen seconded. Vote: Yes-5. The Board signed the warrant articles. White stated the land use ordinance change is the cause for the large number of pages. Article 21

(regarding funding appropriations) is not going to list a dollar amount as it usually does because of the unknown revenue from the State at this point. Grover asked if Don Wiswell was going to moderate the meeting this year. White stated he believed so. White also has invited Senator Youngblood to speak this year. White also passed new estimated revenue figures to the Board.

14. *Town Manager's Report:* White and Public Works Foreman, Brian Stoyell went to a mandatory training for. LPA grant for safety equipment being worked on by Stoyell. Line painting at intersections will begin next week. Town property at Grant Road will be in good shape within the next month or so. This week, painting of the fascia of the town office will begin.

15. *Board Comments:* Goody mentioned water down near J&J Auto on Brewer Lake Road. He wondered if there were beavers there causing low water. Allcroft asked to confirm the date of the class they are signed up for. June 13th is the elected officials workshop. Bladen is signed up for the class on June 4th. Allcroft also reminded the Board of the public hearing on the TIF at the next meeting. White met with Mandy Oliver from the engineering firm regarding work done on Snows Corner Rd. Hydroseeding will begin soon. Grover asked if Public Works was going to get part-time help again this year. White has not decided on that yet.
